The house is overlooking the Sea of Galilee. From every room, there is a sweeping view. The views are towards South and East. Generous openings towards these directions require the provision of shading and filtering the harsh sun, which is provided by the wooden shutters.

The design of the elevations is a contemporary interpretation of the romantic notion of balconies with a view. The vertical proportion of the openings provides continuity of the near view toward the far view adorned by the lake.

The shutters are openable by sliding to respond to the position of the sun and privacy. The lattice of the shutters, as typical to the Mediterranean Mashrabiya, blocks the view from outside while allowing the outdoor view to the inside.

The windows and doors behind the shutters are recessed to improve climate control and creating intermediate spaces of shaded outdoor.
