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The building was designed for Ronimar-Nirflex, an importing company of quality paper, to be used as its headquartre offices, central paper storage warehouse, car park basement and truck docks. It was designed to reflect the company's innovative and international spirit. High-tech details were used, including structural glass wall and exposed systems. The area of the building is 13,500 sqm. The paper storage is located at the ground floor, and as paper is a very heavy material, it led to a heavy looking base to the building. The heavy appearance is balanced in the office levels and entrance lobby, with large openings. The management floor is located at a gallery which is an open office space that is over-looking the paper storage. Above the gallery, there are additional two office levels.
